64	reciprocity – Nebraska has been added, and Nevada has been removed as reciprocal states.
90	Florida jurisdiction on the Atlantic coast extends three miles, or to the western edge of the Gulf Stream (whichever is greater).
100	Recent changes in federal law allows carry of concealed firearms (not other weapons) in National Parks [36 CFR 2.4], and firearms carry in National Wildlife Refuges [50 CFR 27.42] to the extent allowed per state law, except inside any “federal facility”, to wit, a building or structure on such premises where federal employees are “regularly present”. 16 USC 1A-7b; 18 USC 930. Such areas where firearms are prohibited – should be so posted.
133	A new federal definition of “switchblade” excludes from the federal definition a knife that contains a spring, detent, or other mechanism designed to create a “bias toward closure” of the blade, and that requires exertion applied to the blade by hand, wrist, or arm to overcome the bias toward closure to assist in opening the knife. 15 USC 1244(5) This is federal law only.
